

The *EPS Journal* is issued twice a year, in January and in July. For example, for vol. 4 (2009), the time lines would be these:

For vol. 4, no. 1 (January 2009):

First draft due:	30 August 2008
Comments/reviews sent out:	30 September 2008
Revised draft due:	31 October 2008
Pageproofs sent out:	30 November 2008
Proofs returned:	15 December 2008
Publication:	31 December 2008 (official release: January 2009)

For vol. 4, no. 2 (July 2009):

First draft due:	28 February 2009
Comments/reviews sent out:	31 March 2009
Revised draft due:	30 April 2009
Pageproofs sent out:	31 May 2009
Proofs returned:	15 June 2009
Publication:	30 June 2009 [official release: July 2009]

Please do not ask for exceptions to these time lines. Remember to keep your manuscript to between 3-5,000 words (including notes and references). Mathematical expressions, where helpful in exposition, are welcomed, but keep in mind that the journal is aimed in part at a noneconomist audience. It may be more appropriate to place any maths in an appendix.
