

The *EPS Journal* is issued twice a year, in January and in July. For example, for vol. 6 (2011), the time lines would be these:

**For vol. x, no. 1 (January 20xx):**

First draft due: 30 August  
Comments/reviews sent out: 30 September  
Revised draft due: 31 October  
Page proofs sent out: 30 November  
Proofs returned: 15 December  
Publication: 31 December (official release: January)

**For vol. x, no. 2 (July 20xx):**

First draft due: 28 February  
Comments/reviews sent out: 31 March  
Revised draft due: 30 April  
Page proofs sent out: 31 May  
Proofs returned: 15 June  
Publication: 30 June [official release: July]

Please do not ask for exceptions to these time lines. Remember to keep your manuscript to between 3-5,000 words (including notes and references) and to follow the style sheet. Mathematical expressions, where helpful in exposition, are welcomed, but keep in mind that the journal is aimed in part at a noneconomist audience. It may be more appropriate to place any maths in an appendix.
